"Swamp Romp" Schedule of Events: This is a RAIN or SHINE event.

1. The Swamp Romp is scheduled for Saturday May 8, 2010.
2. 7:30 to 9:00 am. - Meet at the Thompson Park North Shelter house for registration. Breakfast will be provided courtesy of the generosity of the UA Rotary Club.
3. 9:00 to 9:30: Opening. Safety Brief. Issue instructions and assignments. Distribute safety equipment.
4. 9:30 Begin "Swamp Romping" – stream cleanup operations.
5. When completed with your assigned stream segment, return the debris to Thompson Park and put the Yuck in the Truck!
6. Units will be dismissed after depositing the debris and taking a group photo.
7. Anticipated completion time 11:00.

Have you done your conservation good turn? The "Swamp Romp" will count toward your Cub Scout, Boy Scout and Girl Scout Conservation Awards as well as service hours.
