

CUB SCOUT SALUTE

Star Frame

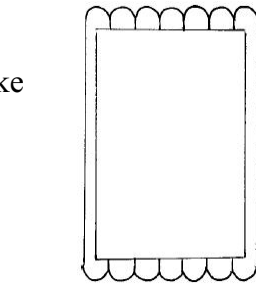
Santa Clara County Council

Materials:

13 popsicle sticks;
Cardboard;
Paint;
Fine-point permanent markers;
Star shapes (wood or craft foam);

Clear plastic sheet (like report cover or sheet protector);
Photo of your hero;
String;
Glue

1. Make a frame with 6 popsicle sticks, two on each side, one on top and one on bottom.
2. Cut cardboard to 2 ½" x 3 ½" Cover it with glue and lay the remaining 7 sticks side by side, touching each other. This is the backing.
3. Paint the frame and backing (on the popsicle stick side) any color you desire.
4. If you are using wooden shapes, paint them.
5. Draw design on the frame with markers. (First practice on paper and decide what you want to draw.)
6. Glue star shapes onto the frame.
7. Put the photo of your hero behind the frame to see if it fits. If it's too big, trim the photo.
8. Trace the photo on a clear plastic sheet. Cut the clear plastic. Tape it to the photo. This will protect the photo.
9. Glue or tape the photo on the sides of the frame.
10. Attach the backing.
11. Tie string to the top horizontal popsicle. Hang the frame.



Saluting Cub Scout Slide

MATERIALS :

1 Round Clothes Pin or Craft Doll Clothes Pin
1 Bump of Blue Bump Chenille
2" Yellow Chenille
Blue Paint or Permanent Marker

Red, Orange and Blue Fine Line Markers
Slide Ring
Drill with 1/8" Drill Bit
Glue Gun

1. Drill a hole through the clothes pin at right angles to the slot. Position the hole at the shoulder of the pin.
2. Glue the Slide ring to back of the clothes pin.
3. Paint the clothes pin blue from the neck down and on the very top to form the uniform and cap. Add the facial features with the fine line markers.
4. Run the blue Chenille bump through the hole and bend the left arm down to the side.
5. Wrap the yellow Chenille around the neck and twist in front to form the neckerchief.
6. Bend the right arm up in a salute and glue both arms into place at the hands and the neckerchief if necessary.



Flag Slide

MATERIALS

United States Flag (approximately 2x3)
Heavy plastic, cut the same size as your flag
¾ inch PVC slide ring



DIRECTIONS

Glue the flag to the piece of heavy plastic
Mount the slide ring to the back of the heavy plastic

Materials:

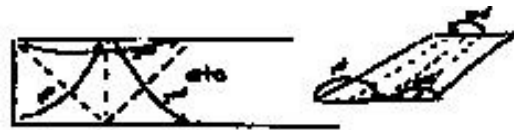
Small Storage Box
Paint Markers
First Aid and/or Emergency Supplies:
Band-Aids, Antiseptic Cream, Safety Pins, Q-Tips, Needle & Thread,
Quarters
Decorate a small storage box with paint markers. Fill with supplies.



Folded Flag Slide

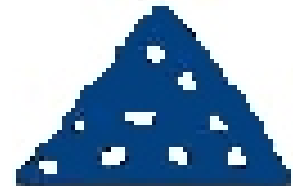
Materials: 8 X 8 ½" Gingham with Star Pattern
5/8" "D" Ring or craft ring

Tools: Scissors,
Needle & Dark Thread



Directions:

1. Fold the material from each edge to the middle to form rectangle 3" X 8 ½". Fold in half one more time to form a long rectangle 1 ½" X 8 ½". The raw edges of the fabric should be, folded into the middle of the rectangle.
2. Fold the long rectangle in the triangle fold used for the American Flag and tuck in the tail to make a neat triangle. 3. Sew a stitch about 2/3 of the way up the triangle with one peak up to hold the "flag" together and then continue to overcast stitch around the edge of the ring to hold it in place. Tie off the thread and cut off the excess.



Outdoor Grill Fire Fighter

Use an empty, plastic detergent bottle for the fireman.
A yellow bottle works well for the fireman's coat.
With magic markers, draw on hair and face.
Outline the fireman's coat and arms.
Keep the bottle filled with water, ready to hand to use when the burgers start burning.



First Aid Tie Slide Kit

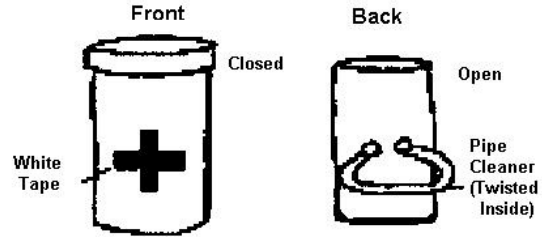

What you need:

- Black plastic film canister
- (available free at most places that develop film)
- Pipe cleaner
- White tape for cross on outside

Medical supplies for kit:

- 1 Quarter (for phone)
- Band-Aids
- Q-tip swabs
- Towelettes (Nice-n-clean)



Poke 2 holes in back of film canister for pipe cleaner. Place canister over end of broomstick for support, then use hammer and nail to make holes. Thread pipe cleaner through holes and twist together inside canister. Cut two pieces of white tape to form cross on front of canister. Then put all medical supplies inside and replace top. Now you have a tie slide and a small first aid kit.

Large U.S. Flag Beadie

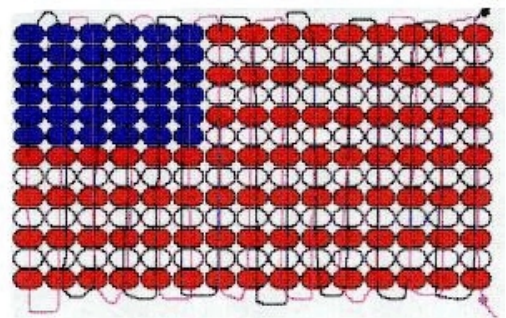
